A very warm welcome to you all. We are looking forward to working with you and your children. We are always available for a chat, so if you have any worries or concerns, please speak to your key person.

We are delighted with how well the children are settling. If your child does become upset when you leave, it is best to keep your goodbye short and sweet. You can always call to check they are OK, and we will contact you if there are any problems.

If your child is poorly, please keep them at home, even if they are insistent that they want to come. We also ask that you keep them at home for 24 hours after a sickness bug, and 48 hours after a tummy upset, to prevent bugs from spreading.

At the beginning and end of sessions — please keep your children with you, and do not allow them to play on any of the Nursery equipment, climb fences or go on the grass. Please leave buggies outside the door, the door lady will always keep an eye on sleeping babies or toddlers if you ask her.

The children need to bring a coat every day, as we go outside in all weathers. Also, please send warm coats/gloves/hats as the weather gets colder. Please make sure that everything is named, including the drawstring bag containing their spare clothes.

Please try to remember to pay the voluntary contribution of £1 per week to enable us to continue to provide lovely grub at snack time.

Once we are all in and settled, we will send you more information about Forest School, the Nursery Library Scheme, and 2Simple, which is the secure system we use for sharing observations of your child with you.
